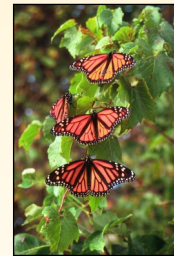

## **Thorold Seniors Centre, 8 Carlton Street South, Thorold L2V 5C2**



### **Directions**

From the north of Thorold: Hwy. 406 south to Albert Street East in Thorold. Continue to Carlton Street South. The Seniors Centre is on the right side of Carlton. Parking is beside the building.

From the west of Thorold: Hwy. 20 east to Hwy. 406 north St. Catharines. Take exit 11B to Hwy. ON 58 south. Turn left on Pine St./Regional Rd. 67 exit. Turn right on Richmond St./Regional Rd. 52. Turn right on Clairmont. Turn left on Carlton Street South (first cross street). The Seniors Centre is on the right side of Carlton. Parking is beside the building.

From the east or south of Thorold: QEW north, exit #32 (Regional Rd. 57/Thorold Stone Rd.). Continue on Reg. Rd. 57—this becomes Regional Rd. 58, signs for Thorold. Exit (turn right) at Pine Street/Regional Rd. 67. Turn right on to Richmond St./Regional Rd. 52. Turn right on Clairmont St. Turn left on Carlton Street South (first cross street). The Seniors Centre is on the right side of Carlton. Parking is beside the building.
